Do you have a bachelor's degree and a desire to teach as a substitute? If so, the Guest Teacher program is for you!

The Guest Teacher program provides substitute teacher training to people who have a bachelor's degree *but do not have a Pennsylvania teaching certificate. The interactive training sessions will provide strategies for effective instruction and management of traditional, non-traditional and special education classrooms, as well as offer a variety of resources. Applicants also will be required to complete a classroom observation that is arranged by CSIU staff.

Participants who complete the program will receive an emergency permit issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) and the basic knowledge to be an effective substitute teacher who can sub 20 days per teacher per school year.

REQUIRED TRAINING SESSIONS

All guest teachers are required to attend two days of training. Trainers and speakers include CSIU education and special education professionals.

Thursday, Oct. 10, 2019 – full day of training at **Shikellamy School District**

Friday, Oct. 11, 2019 - All participants will be required to do one classroom observation, which will be set up by CSIU staff for Friday morning and will reconvene for the second half of training in the afternoon.

Are you an Education Major with at least 60 completed credit hours? Do you want to teach as a substitute? If so, get some valuable training at the CSIU!

The Education Major portion of the program provides substitute teacher training to college students who have completed at least 60 credit hours.

The interactive training sessions will provide strategies for effective instruction and management of traditional, non-traditional and special education classrooms, as well as offer a variety of resources. Applicants also will be required to complete a classroom observation that is arranged by CSIU staff.

Participants who complete the Education Major program will receive a Locally Issued Permit allowing for up to 20 days of substitution per school year.

REQUIRED TRAINING SESSIONS

All education majors who meet the requirements and are interested in teaching as a substitute are required to attend two days of training. Trainers and speakers include CSIU education and special education professionals.
